The bill was introduced recently by Senator Lisa Murkowski from Alaska, and is a companion bill to the one announced by Representative Mike Coffman from Colorado at our TREM10 event in March.

Nearly 100 people registered to be on the call including participants from the House of Representatives, the Senate, the Alaskan State Legislature, the Department of Energy, the Department of Defense, the Bureau of Land Management, the USGS and the Australian Embassy.
